



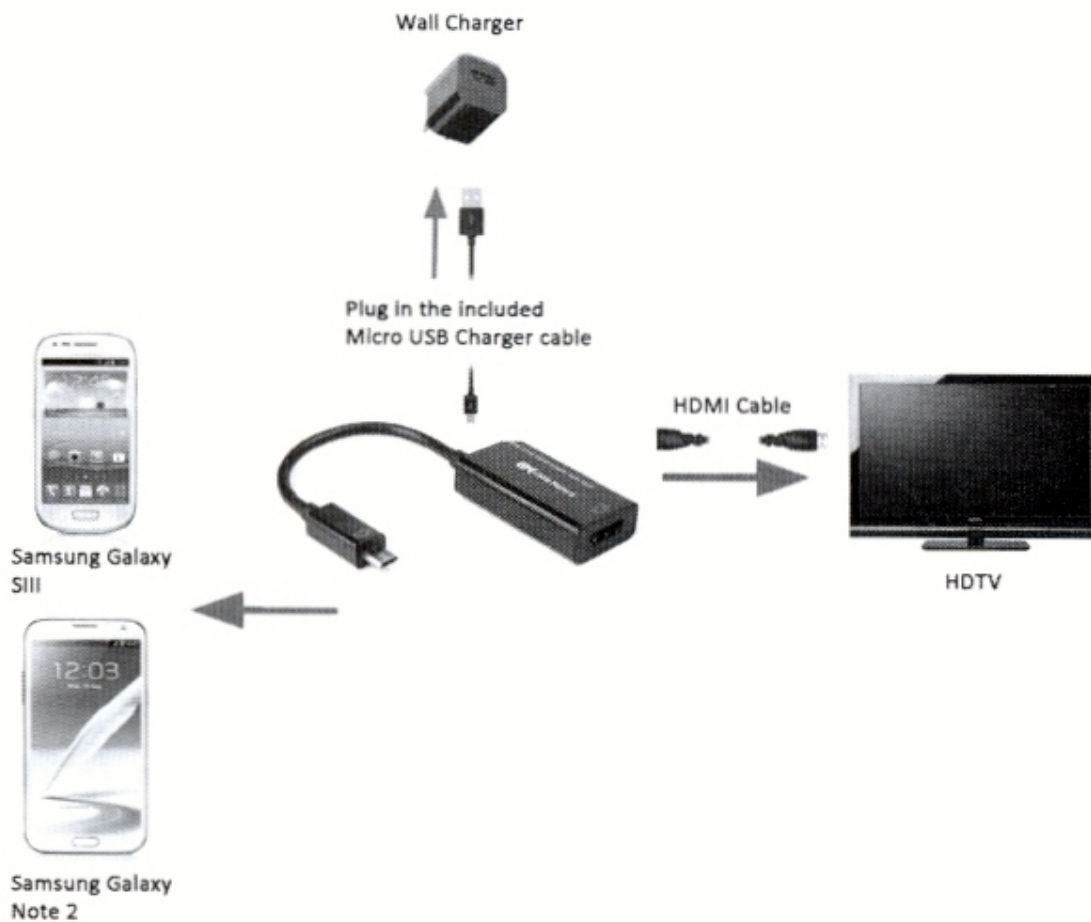

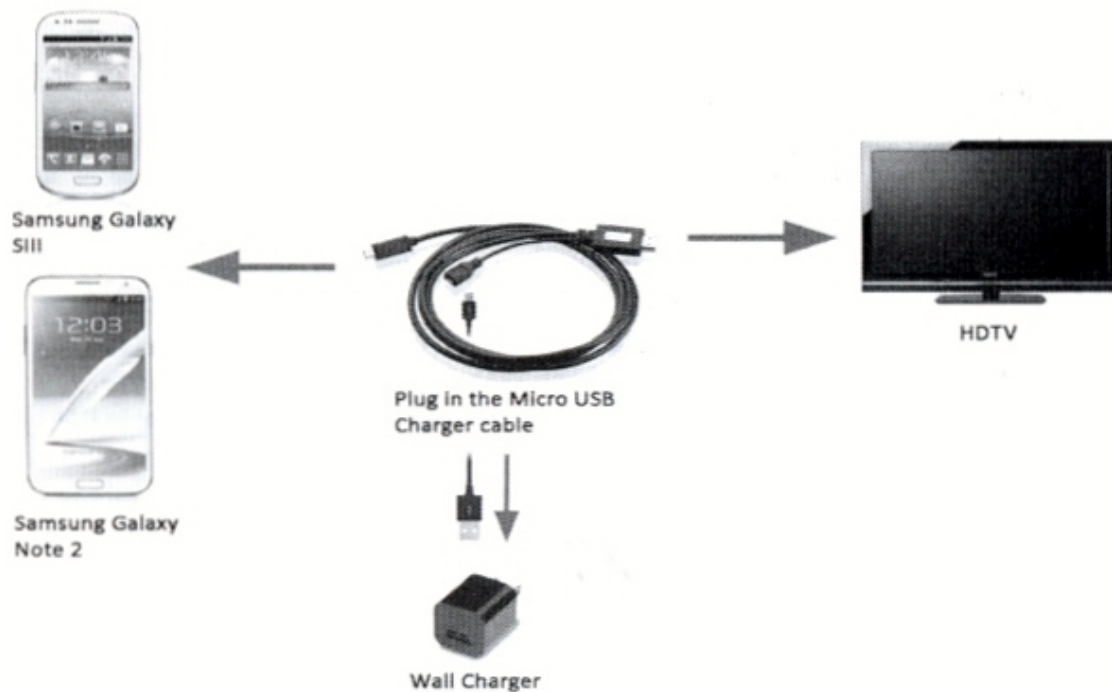
**Micro USB (MHL 2.0) to HDMI Adapter/Cable with

Note 2/Note 3**



CONNECTION DIAGRAM

1. Before installation, please make sure all the devices you wish to connect have been turned off.
2. Connect the Micro USB (MHL) input of this product to your Phone / Tablet.
3. Connect the HDMI output of this product to your HDTV.
4. Plug in the USB Power cable to power this adapter/cable.





TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Please make sure all connections are tight and secure.
2. Choose the correct video input on your HDTV (HDMI input).
3. This MHL to HDMI adapter/cable requires external power to work. Please plug in the included USB power cable to supply power to this adapter/cable (**refer to Connection Diagram**).
4. If there is no video showing up on TV, please restart the phone/tablet.
5. Built-in USB port only supplies power for the adapter. It does not charge your smartphone device.
